

## 4th AONSA Neutron School in Japan Canceled

As reported by TV and others, the Tohoku-Kanto (Northeast and Central) Area of Japan suffered a calamity by a large earthquake of M9.0 and following giant tsunami on March 11, 2011. J-PARC and JRR-3 were not exceptions, and lifeline, buildings, roads, and facilities were seriously damaged. J-PARC Center, JAEA, and KEK are now investigating damages of the facilities. It will take some time before announcing estimated day of recovery by J-PARC/JRR-3. Although we had planned to serve a chance to study at state-of-the-art neutron instruments at J-PARC/MLF and JRR-3 on the occasion of the 4<sup>th</sup> AONSA Neutron School, we had to accept that it is impossible to realize it. All staffs of J-PARC Center, JAEA, and KEK are devoted to work on for repair.

Considering these facts, I am sorry to announce that it would be impossible to hold the school this year and would like to propose to postpone 4<sup>th</sup> AONSA Neutron School to next year or to hold a school in another country. The final decision will be made at the next AONSA EC Meeting on May 19-21, 2011, Bandung, Indonesia. I look forward to seeing you in Tokai in the near future.
